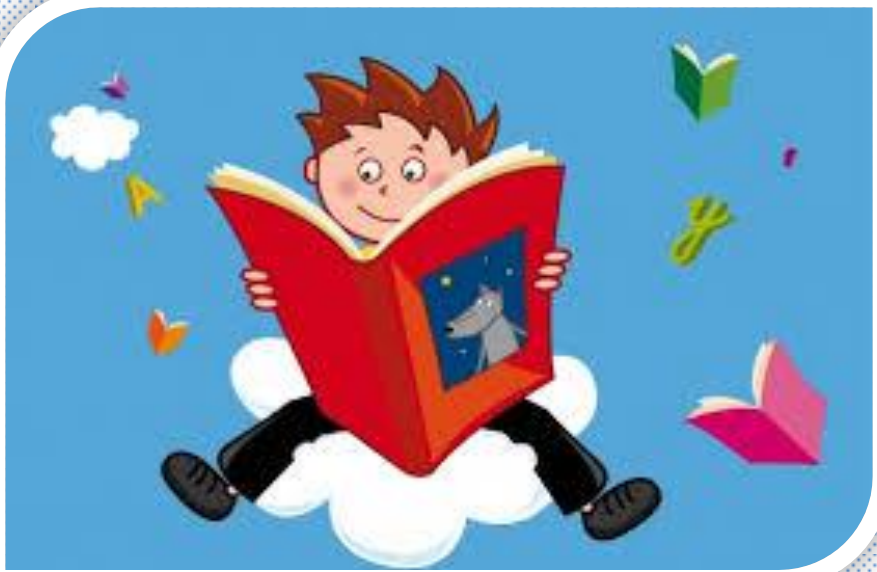

## Further Aims I



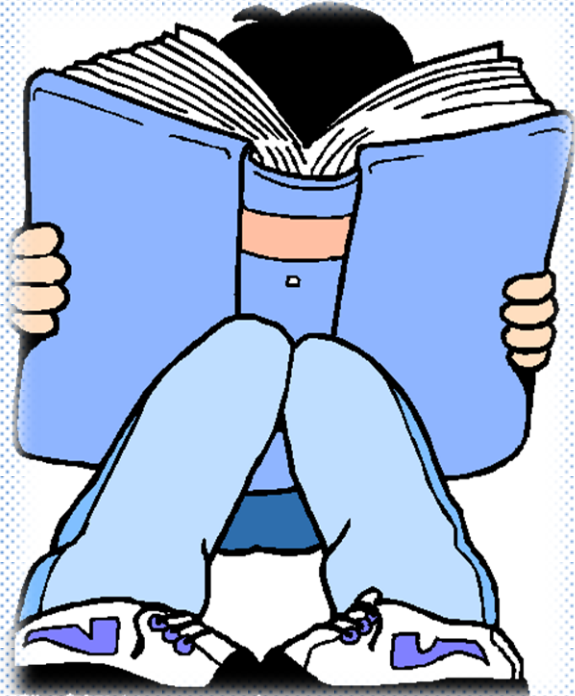
### A. With reference to literature

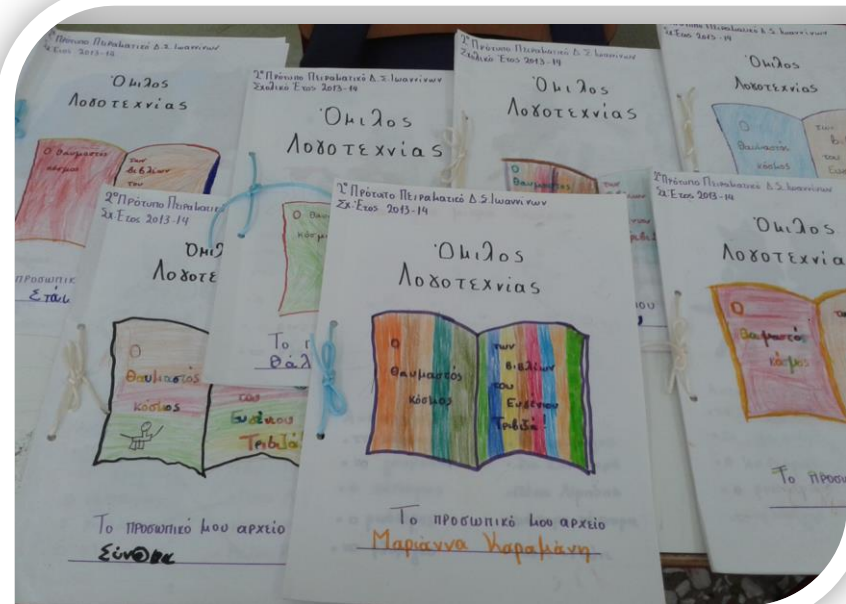
# Our E-twinning book

scooters...

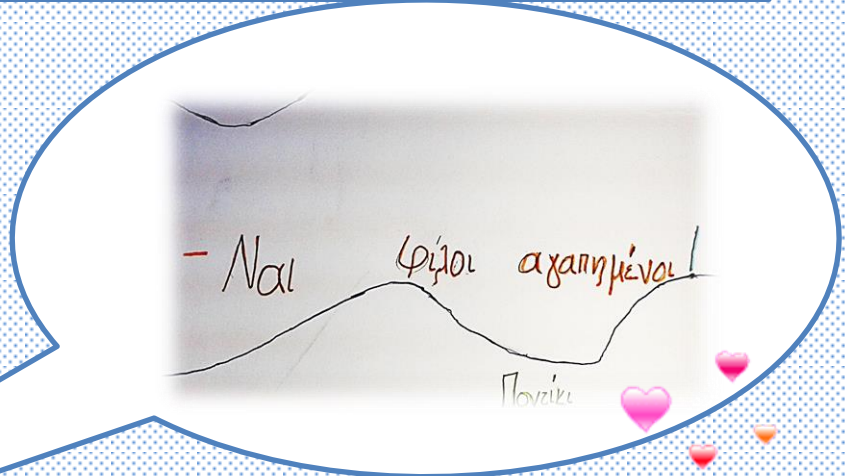

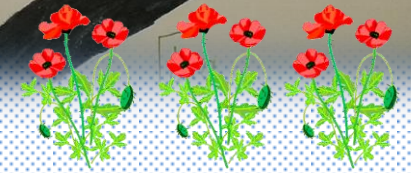

# Ignatius and the cat



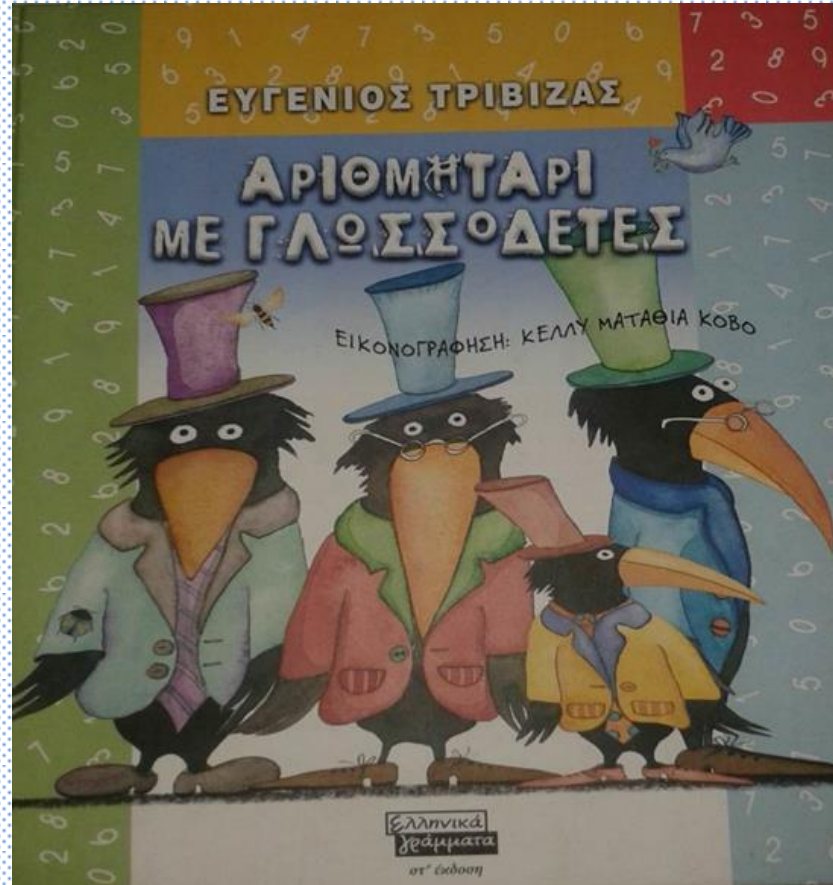
The children create a poster with scenes from the book, They find the core meanings and finally they propose a new, happy end to the story







# Numbers and tongue twisters

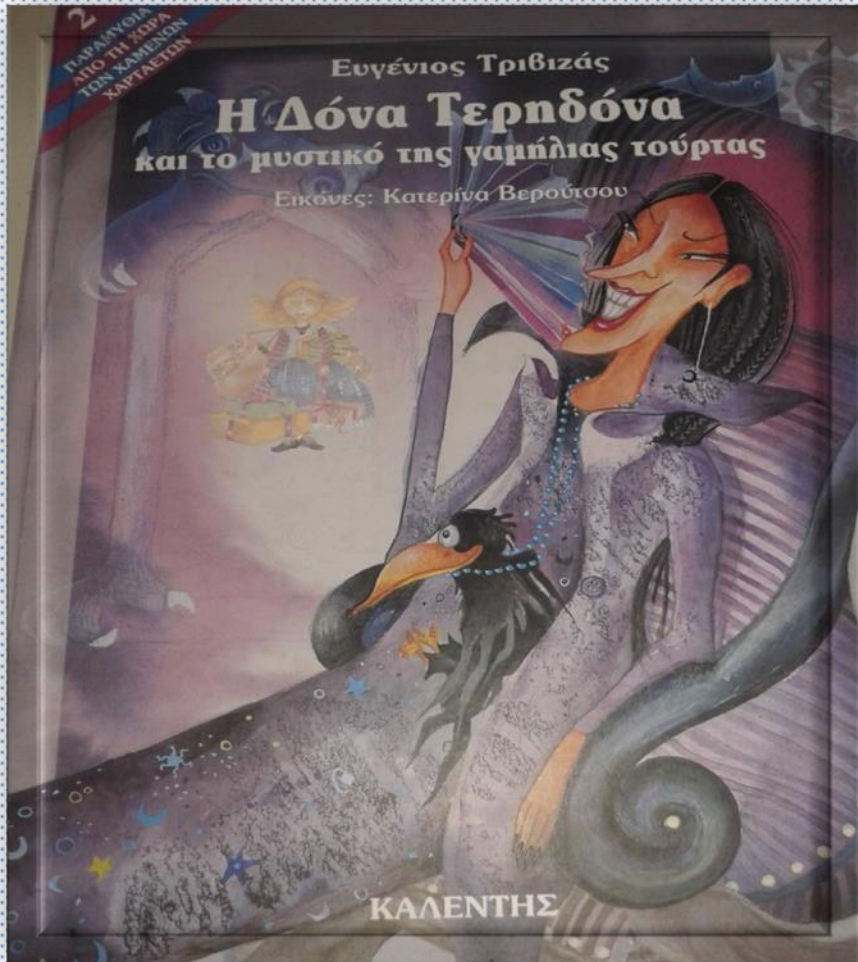

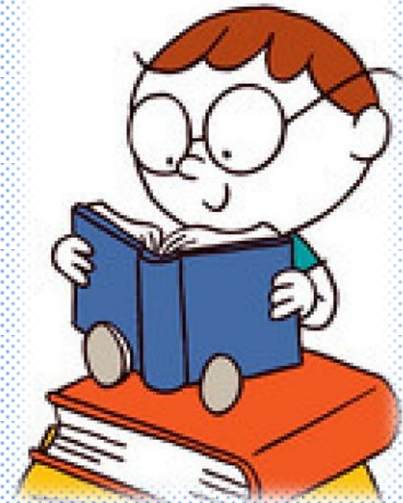
The children write the numbers 1-100 with coloured paper
